A visit to 360 Play can complement all six Girlguiding programme themes, with activities and experiences throughout the centre creating natural opportunities to explore Skills for My Future, Know Myself, Express Myself, Be Well, Have Adventures and Take Action.

This guide is designed to help leaders identify opportunities throughout the centre that could support their programme and make badge activities part of an exciting group day out. Leader guidance will still be required throughout the visit to ensure all individual badge requirements and programme elements are completed in full.

Whether you're planning a unit outing, working towards programme themes or simply looking for a fun way to bring everyone together, 360 Play offers an exciting environment where Rainbows and Brownies can play, explore and develop skills together.

Rainbows Interest Badges

AGILITY

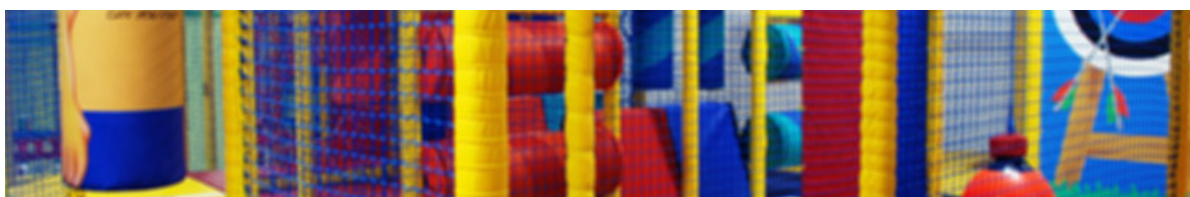
The Agility Interest Badge focuses on developing agility, exploring different types of movement and practicing moving quickly and easily.

A 360 Play Agility Badge Adventure could include movement challenges around the playframe, encouraging Rainbows to explore different ways of moving and challenge their physical skills.

COURAGE

The Courage Interest Badge encourages Rainbows to explore bravery, confidence and trying new things.

A 360 Play visit could provide opportunities to put this into practice through positive affirmations in Twirl's Boutique, taking on a new challenge within the playframe or trying an unfamiliar activity or role within 360 Street. At the end, Rainbows could reflect on something they tried that they initially felt nervous or unsure about.



Brownies Interest Badges

JOBS

The Jobs Interest Badge has particularly strong links to 360 Street, where children can explore different careers through Imaginative play. Taking small groups of Brownies along the street on a Jobs Trail could encourage Brownies to explore careers including:

- Chefs, Servers and Restaurant Managers in Luigi's Pizzeria
- Vets, Veterinary Nurse and Receptionist in our Vets N Pets
- Mechanic and Engineer in Twizzle's Garage
- Builder, Architect and Engineer in Build it, Break it
- Retail, Management and Customer Service in our Supermarket
- Fire Fighter in our Fire Station
- Post People in our Post Office

Brownies could identify different jobs, explore the skills needed for each and think about careers they might like to learn more about.

INVENTING

The Games Master Interest Badge explores games, creating games and testing ideas with other people.

At 360 Play, Brownies could explore different ways of playing before creating their own simple game. They could decide the aim of the game, create the rules, explain it to their friends and then test it together in our playframe before reflecting on what worked and what they would change.

CELEBRATIONS

The Celebrations Interest Badge explores celebrations, bringing people together and creating memories.

A Brownie celebration visit could combine structured activities with a group celebration at 360 Play. Brownies could explore different types of celebrations, think about what makes a celebration special and help plan elements of their own group celebration before enjoying the experience together.
